Learning Program

Every day camp begins at 9:00 AM promptly for boys finishing grades 3-5. There will be a שחרית מנין for grades 5 & up at 9:00 AM followed by breakfast starting the **2nd day of camp**. The following seforim will be needed:

For boys finishing grades 3 & 4: סידור & חומש במדבר ודברים, משניות תענית

For boys finishing grade 5: סידור & חומש במדבר ודברים, גמרא מגילה פרק הקורא עומד

For boys finishing grades 6-10: חומש במדבר ודברים, גמרא מגילה Notebook & Pen

Afternoon Schedule

Lunch will be served in camp after learning. We will then leave the building for activities. There will be snacks served between activities. If you would like to send snacks along please ensure they are completely nut free. Drinks will be available at all times. The 3rd, 4th & 5th graders will end camp at 6:30 PM. The rest of the boys will have supper, night seder, night activity and then be dismissed at 7:45 PM (there isn't any bus transportation home at that time). The following items are needed; sneakers, bathing suit, towel, sunscreen, and baseball glove. Please mark all personal belongings so they can be returned if lost. All belongings that are left at the end of each session will be considered הפקר.

On Friday camp ends at 12:30 PM.

Your son should always be instructed to go directly to camp, and go directly home after camp. Please inform the camp office if there is a change so he is accounted for.
